Closet on the Corner specializes in carefully curated women's clothing, shoes, handbags, and accessories. We focus on quality, style, and desirable brands to provide our customers with a boutique shopping experience.

All accepted items remain the property of the Consignor until sold.

Item Acceptance

Closet on the Corner reserves the right to accept or decline any item for any reason.

Items should be:

- Freshly cleaned
- Free of stains, odors, holes, excessive wear, and pet hair
- In excellent, current style
- Authentic (designer items must be genuine; may require proof of authenticity)
- In working condition (zippers, buttons, clasps, etc.)

Acceptance of an item does not guarantee it will sell.

Pricing

Closet on the Corner will determine the selling price of all accepted items based on:

- Brand
- Condition
- Style
- Current market demand
- Retail value

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- Seasonal trends

Pricing decisions are made solely by Closet on the Corner.

Markdowns may be applied throughout the selling period to maximize the likelihood of a sale.

Commission

Once an item sells, proceeds will be split as follows:

Consignor: 60%

Closet on the Corner: 40%

Payment will be issued after the sale according to the payment schedule below.

Payment Schedule

Consignors may choose one of the following payment methods:

- ☐ Venmo

Payments will be issued:

Monthly by the 10th for items sold during the previous month.

Consignment Period

Items will remain available for sale for:

90 Days

After the consignment period:

- The Consignor may schedule a pickup.
- Closet on the Corner may donate any items not picked up within 30 days after notification.

Unsold Items

The Consignor is responsible for collecting unsold items within 30 days after being notified.

Items not collected within this timeframe become the property of Closet on the Corner and may be donated, sold, or otherwise disposed of without further notice.

Item Care

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Closet on the Corner agrees to handle all merchandise with reasonable care.

However, Closet on the Corner is not responsible for loss or damage resulting from:

- Fire
- Flood
- Theft
- Natural disasters
- Customer handling
- Circumstances beyond reasonable control

Authenticity

The Consignor certifies that:

- They are the legal owner of all consigned items.
- All designer merchandise is authentic.
- No item is counterfeit or stolen.

Closet on the Corner reserves the right to reject or remove any item whose authenticity is questioned.

Early Withdrawal

Items may not be withdrawn before the end of the consignment period without prior approval from Closet on the Corner.

Approved withdrawals may be subject to a handling fee of \$20 per item.

Donations

Closet on the Corner may donate any items that remain after the pickup deadline.

No compensation will be issued for donated items.

Communication

The Consignor agrees to maintain current contact information.

Closet on the Corner will communicate primarily by:
