How Consignment Works

Step 1

Schedule your appointment.

Step 2

Bring your freshly cleaned clothing, shoes, handbags, and accessories.

Step 3

We carefully review each item and select pieces that fit our boutique.

Step 4

Accepted items are photographed, priced, tagged, and entered into inventory.

Step 5

Your items are marketed both in-store and online.

Step 6

When an item sells, you'll receive your agreed-upon commission.

Step 7

At the end of the consignment period, you'll pick up any unsold items or choose to donate them.

- Swimwear (unless new with tags)
- Formalwear unless pre-approved

Resale Price Examples

These are typical selling ranges to help set expectations. Final prices are set at intake based on condition, demand, and seasonality.

Lululemon leggings	\$45–65
Lululemon tops / define jackets	\$40–70
Free People tops	\$28–48
Athleta jackets	\$35–60
Madewell jeans	\$35–55
Vuori joggers / sets	\$40–70
Alo Yoga pieces	\$35–65
Farm Rio / Johnny Was	\$40–75
Premium denim (Paige, AG, etc.)	\$40–80
Boutique dresses	\$30–55
Handbags (premium / designer)	Case by case

Payment Schedule Overview

Commission is 60% to the Consignor and 40% to Closet on the Corner.

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Payments are issued monthly for items sold during the previous month (see the Payment Schedule PDF for full details).

You may choose:

- Venmo
- PayPal
- Store credit — with a 10% bonus on your commission (for example, if your items sell for \$100, your \$60 commission becomes \$66 in store credit)

Items remain on consignment for 90 days. Unsold items must be picked up within 30 days after notification.

Consignment Agreement Summary

- All items are accepted at Closet on the Corner's discretion.
- Pricing is determined based on market value, condition, brand, and demand.
- Items remain on consignment for the agreed-upon consignment period.
- Items may be discounted during promotional events.
- Payment is issued after qualifying sales according to our payout schedule.
- Unsold items must be picked up within the designated pickup period.

Frequently Asked Questions

How do you price my items?

We research current resale values, brand demand, condition, and market trends to determine competitive pricing.

Do all of my items get accepted?

Not always. We carefully curate our inventory to maintain a consistent shopping experience.

Where will my items be sold?

Items may be sold in our boutique, through our website, or on select online marketplaces.

Can prices be reduced?

Yes. Items may be marked down during promotions or toward the end of the consignment period to increase the likelihood of a sale.

When do I get paid?

Payments are issued according to our published payout schedule after eligible sales are finalized.
